The first building to implement the Suncrest Village Center Plan is the General Store. With sufficient surrounding dwellings inhabited to support a small store, the building was designed as a social center and provide daily conveniences to a remote setting.

The building takes several cues from its site. At a prominent corner within the Village Center, the north facing gable with prominent front terrace and corner entry welcomes the arriving resident to the center. The lower wing of the building is inflected to define the future plaza and skating rink to the south side, and presents a low gable entry porch to the focal area of the sales offices and the green.
