DESIGN DEVELOPMENT

A riding academy has expanded operations to focus on teaching for physical disabilities. A plan for the 8 acre site, concept architectural drawings, and marketing literature were prepared for fund raising.

In addition to renovations for two barns, new structures were given preliminary design definition: Open frames for hay and feed, a covered round pen, garages, a director's dwelling, and the main rooms serving the Foundation (library, administration, conference, guest quarters, and kitchen). The dwelling and Foundation rooms form the Academy Building, which is configured as a gate house - marking the point of arrival, sheltering the drop-off for guests, and screening equestrian activity from the road at the front.
